- 1** **Aker Brygge**
A popular local Oslo neighborhood known for its shopping and dining (Map-1,3)
- 2** **Akershus Castle & Fortress**
A natural fortress-castle in Oslo built by King Haakon V (Map-1,3)
- 3** **Armed Forces Museum**
An armed forces museum that showcases Norway's defense from the Viking Age till World War II (Map-1,3)
- 4** **Astrup Fearnley Museum of Modern Art**
A museum of contemporary art that is a critical part of Oslo's art institution scene (Map-1,3)
- 5** **City Hall**
Oslo's City Hall, which has been an important landmark in the city from the time of its construction (Map-1,3)
- 6** **Ekebergparken Sculpture Park**
A fantastic sculpture park in Oslo that has over 31 brilliant sculptures and is today a national heritage park (Map-1)
- 7** **Fram Museum**
A museum dedicated to the Norwegian Polar exploration that honors Fridtjof Nansen, Roald Amundsen, and Otto Svedrup (Map-1,2,3)
- 8** **Historical Museum**
Home of the Historical Museum as well as the Viking Ship Museum (Map-1,3)
- 9** **Holmenkollen Ski Jump & Museum**
A ski jump area with state of the art equipment and a Ski Jump Tower that is the best in the world (Map-1)
- 10** **Holocaust Center**
An important foundation created by the University of Oslo that focuses on the Holocaust and religious minorities (Map-1,2)
- 11** **Hovedøya island**
A lovely island near Oslo that is known for its flowers, vegetation, and beaches (Map-1)
- 12** **Ibsen Museum**
A fascinating museum dedicated to the life and works of renowned playwright Henrik Ibsen (Map-1,3)
- 13** **Kon-tiki Museum**
A museum built to commemorate Thor Heyerdahl's epic voyage across the Pacific on the raft Kon-Tiki (Map-1,2,3)
- 14** **Munch Museum**
A superb museum dedicated to the life and works of Edward Munch (Map-1,3)
- 15** **National Museum of Contemporary Art**
An amazing contemporary art museum which is part of the Museum of Art, Architecture, and Design (Map-1,3)
- 16** **National Museum of Decorative Arts and Design**
A fantastic museum with over 35,000 exhibits from the world of decorative arts (Map-1,3)
- 17** **Natural History Museum**
Norway's oldest and largest natural history museum (Map-1,3)
- 18** **Nobel Peace Center**
A museum that is dedicated exclusively to the Nobel Peace Prize and its winners (Map-1,3)
- 19** **Nordmarka**
A superb patch of woodland close to the city of Oslo that offers great opportunities for outdoor activities
- 20** **Norwegian Folk Museum**
The largest cultural history museum in all of Norway (Map-1,2)
- 21** **Norwegian Maritime Museum**
A fantastic museum in Oslo dedicated to the maritime history of Norway (Map-1,2,3)
- 22** **Norwegian Museum of Science and Technology**
A museum that showcases the journey of science in Norway from the 19th century till the 21st century (Map-1)
- 23** **Oslo Cathedral**
A renowned cathedral that is patronized by the Royal Family of Norway (Map-1,3)
- 24** **Oslo Fjord**
A natural attraction that comprises numerous islands and covers over 100 kilometers near Oslo (Map-1,3)
- 25** **Oslo Opera House**
A grand structure with 3 performance areas that is the home of the Norwegian National Opera (Map-1,3)
- 26** **Royal Palace**
A monument and museum that continues to be the official residence of the King of Norway (Map-1,3)
- 27** **Sognsvann Lake**
A beautiful lake offering a perfect escape to nature (Map-1)
- 28** **The National Gallery**
A superb museum in Oslo with the single largest collection of Norwegian art right from the Romantic Era (Map-1,3)
- 29** **The National Museum – Architecture**
An architectural museum that is a branch of the National Museum of Art, Architecture, and Design (Map-1,3)
- 30** **Transport Museum**
A tramway museum that has in its collection a large number of trams and trolleybuses from earlier times (Map-1)

A museum showcasing the life and works of Gustav Vigeland and housed in his apartment and studio (Map-1,3)

A unique museum that showcases the Viking ships excavated at Tune, Gokstad, and Oseberg (Map-1,2)
